The Digital India Week would be formally launched in an event at New Delhi on July 1, 2015. Several new products and e-services such as Digital Locker are to be launched during the inaugural event.

A week from 1<sup>st</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 is earmarked for programmes comprising of awareness and communication events to be organised across the country to effectively deliver the message of Digital India to the citizens. The events would be conducted at different levels starting from the village level, block, municipality, sub-division, district, state and national level to make people in general and all levels of government in particular to communicate the transformative impact of the Digital India programme.
